CONTINUING NURSING EDUCATION (CNE) CONTACT HOURS:

- 1. Attendees may be provided up to 15.25 contact hours for the conference depending on the sessions attended. **CNE breakdown:**
 - Pre-Conference Independent Study Option 2.0 contact hours are available for an independent study option involving a pre-conference reading and writing assignment on obesity prevention. This assignment must be completed before and submitted to Mary Bell at the conference.  - Conference 13.25 contact hours will be available at the full conference. Fewer contact hours are available for partial attendance. In order to receive nursing contact hours for the sessions attended, the entire plenary presentation or breakout session must be attended. Sign in each day at the conference is required to receive your CNE certification.

University of Alaska Credits: the conference has been approved by UAS for one credit, as a pass/no pass course for individuals completing all 15.25 contact hours. As a pass/no pass course it may or may not apply towards salary advancement for ASD nurses. A certain number of graduate credits must reflect a grade of "B" or higher in order to qualify for lane change. It depends on the individual and how many graduate credits they have as to whether this credit will count for lane change. ASD nurses should all be able to use the credit towards your Type-C certificate.

To receive credit: you must fill out a UAS registration form on first day of conference and pay \$45 to UAS. A separate UAS course evaluation form must also be filled out and returned by the end of the conference. Dianne Swanson will have these forms available at the registration table.
